

## Information and Nomination Form

The Scottish Cancer Foundation invites nominations for its 2017 prize, which will be awarded to the person who, in the opinion of the Scottish Cancer Foundation Board, has made the most significant contribution to reducing the burden of cancer in Scotland.

Applicants may be nominated or be self-nominated. The applicant need not be a health professional, but must be living and working in Scotland at the time of the award. The nature of their contribution is not specified, and the prize is open to anyone whose work has had a significant impact on cancer in Scotland, although evidence of wider impact would be welcomed.

### The Prize

The Prize, of up to £10,000, is awarded annually at the Scottish Cancer Conference. It is supported by the Grant Simpson Trust. The Prize will be accompanied by The Evans Forrest Medal, named in recognition of the founders of the Scottish Cancer Foundation.

### Nominations

Nominations should be sent to the Scottish Cancer Foundation either by mail or electronically, making a case, written by the nominator, as to why the nominee should be considered.

The nomination is to be accompanied by a short account, written by the nominee, as to how the prize money would be used to forward his or her work in cancer. This account is to be limited to 750 words.

This form should be completed with information on both the nomination and the case for the prize money.

The closing date for nominations is **Thursday, 31st August 2017**.
