

Information and Nomination Form

The Scottish Cancer Foundation invites nominations for the 2023 Prize which will be for an early career researcher (within 5 years of receiving a doctorate) who has made a significant contribution to Cancer Prevention.

Applicants may be nominated self-nominated. The applicant(s) must be living and working in Scotland at the time of the award. The prize is open to any researcher and is not restricted to medically qualified professionals. Their work must be of direct relevance to Scotland, although evidence of wider impact would be welcomed. The application should provide an objective assessment of the impact of the work.

The Prize

The Prize, up to £10,000, is supported by the Grant Simpson Trust. It is accompanied by the Evans Forrest Medal, named in recognition of the founders of the Scottish Cancer Foundation.

Nominations

Nominations should be sent to the Scottish Cancer Foundation electronically, making a case, written by the nominator, as to why the nominee should be considered.

The nomination is to be accompanied by a short account, written by the nominee, as to how the prize money would be used to forward his or her work in cancer. This account is to be limited to 750 words.

This form should be completed with information on both the nomination and the case for the prize money.

The closing date for nominations is **Wednesday 31st May 2023**.
